RxCheckup Pays for Consultations With Network Pharmacists

- Provides advice to avoid possible problems, such as adverse effects and drug interactions.
- Monitors conditions affected by medications, such as blood pressure, cholesterol and blood sugars.
- Works with physicians to resolve identified concerns or make cost-reduction recommendations.

Because CoOportunity Health pays for the services in full, there's nothing for members to pay following the visit.


